All cost-share contracts come with expectations of maintenance and if awarded have expected completion timelines. Proposals are scored and approved by the Dare Soil & Water Conservation Board, and then submitted to the NC Soil & Water Conservation Commission. Due to limited funding, not all proposals will be approved. There is no limit on the number of years you may apply. The cost-share is 75%, but is dispersed via reimbursement. Some BMPs require the designs to be drafted and approved by professional engineers. **The recipient is responsible for all costs up front.** Please do not apply if you can not cover the upfront costs. Do not hesitate to contact staff with any questions!
