- 1. Each edible creation must be a representation of a fiction or non-fiction book. Edible books can look like a book, be inspired by a book or author, can be a pun of a book title, can refer to a book character, or just have something to do with books in general.
- 2. Entries must be made out of edible materials that can be displayed without melting or getting scary. (No ice cream, for example.)
- 3. Entries should be on a disposable base (cardboard, disposable aluminum pan, paper plates, etc.) Any entries not picked up at the end of the day will be discarded, including the base. (No ants in the library!)
- 4. Complete the entry form when you bring in your entry.
- 5. All entries must be family friendly.
- 6. Age categories: Youth (6-17), Adult (18+) and Group/Organization
- 7. Competition Categories: Most Creative, Healthiest, and Best in Show
