FALL 2024 PROGRAMS



Registration Information:

Registration for fall programs will begin on Wednesday, July 17, 2024, and programs will remain open until the registration deadline or until a program is full. Please refer to each program for specific registration deadlines.

The deadline for registration is Friday, August 30, 2024 unless otherwise noted—or once a program is full. Registration forms are available at the Dare County Parks & Recreation office. Participants can also register online at:

Early registration is highly recommended. There is a \$5 late fee for registering after a program's registration deadline. We accept cash, check, money order, and credit or debit cards.

The age cutoff for all fall programs is September 1, 2024. No exceptions.

IMPORTANT THINGS TO REMEMBER WHEN REGISTERING:

- Registration can be done online or in person. If there are issues with online registration, please call our office for assistance.
- A program is open until it is full. Once a program is full, children will be placed on a waiting list. If space becomes available, participants on the waiting list will be notified.
- Participants must meet the age requirement and play at age.
- Participants will not be allowed to play "up" or "down."
- Programs/schedules are subject to change without notice.
- Refunds for activities and programs will not be issued after that activity or program's
 registration deadline. Exceptions include medical reasons, a participant moving out of the area,
 or if the department cancels or reschedules a program. A \$10 processing fee will be subtracted
 from the refund amount.

YOUTH FOOTBALL:

depending on the weather.

Friday practices will be held from 5:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m.

Registration Deadline: Friday, August 16 or until full

Conditioning (4 Days):

Conditioning will be held on Monday, August 26; Tuesday, August 27; Thursday, August 29; and Friday, August 30. Conditioning will take place from 5:30 p.m. to 7 p.m. at the College of The Albemarle (COA) field in Manteo. <u>Conditioning is mandatory.</u>

Equipment Fittings:



Details:

Space is very limited, and teams will fill up quickly. Please register ASAP so we can determine equipment needs and determine league needs. When a team is full, players will be put on a waitlist and may not be able to be added, so it is imperative that you sign up as soon as possible.

Games are played at Manteo Middle School in Manteo and Family Recreation Park in Kill Devil Hills. A helmet, shoulder pads, pants and a mouthpiece will be provided. No metal cleats will be permitted.

Dance Class Cost:

Cost varies. Please see the charts below and class levels on the next page. Class fees can be paid in full or paid in three (3) payments.*

- 1/3 of each class cost is due at registration.
- 1/3 of the class cost is due on October 18, 2024.
 - Recital costumes will not be ordered if payments are not current.
- The final payment is due on February 14, 2025.
 - Recital costumes will not be received if payment is not completed.

If balances are not paid in full, participants will not be allowed to attend until the balance is paid. A \$15 late fee will be applied to each class after 10 days and will be enforced.

Costs do not include class attire or dance shoes for each dance style. Dancers must follow the Dare County Dance dress code for classes. (The dress code will be included in a welcome email after registering).
